Keep Calm and Carry On!

In 1939, England faced a serious and imminent threat of invasion by Germany. Obviously, this was a serious threat to their national security and to the morale of the English people. During the war, The Ministry of Information was appointed by the British Government to create and distribute a number of morale boosting posters. These posters were designed to go up all

over England to remind the people who they were as a steadfast people.

Two of these posters were distributed, by the thousands, but a third was made and never used. The third poster said, KEEP CALM AND CARRY ON. This third poster was to be issued only if Germany actually invaded. Of course, Germany never

invaded so these posters were never distributed. But isn't this a powerful message? I love this! I love what it states and I love what it communicates, "Hey, no matter what obstacles, no matter what trials, no matter what adversity, no matter what hell may come your way, KEEP CALM AND CARRY ON."

This statement is one powerfully positive persuasive piece of propaganda that can help lead people through times of high anxiety and fear; but if you take these words, and place them in the context of the Christian faith, they can become a powerfully persuasive proclamation of the Gospel! KEEP CALM AND CARRY ON can change from propaganda to proclamation when Jesus is added to the mix. KEEP CALM AND CARRY ON can become so much more than a simple statement of positive thinking when its grounded on the truth of that Jesus is the Lord of Life and Peace and that He is in control.

See, because Jesus has authority over everything (everything in the physical world and everything in the spiritual world), because Jesus is in control... we can be at peace in the midst of chaos. When storms come our way, when adversity gets up in our face, when anxiety and fear swell up around us or within us, when evil reveals itself in the midst of innocence, we can KEEP CALM AND CARRY ON because we know Who's in charge and we know that the sky is not falling. Through the power of the Holy Spirit we can receive this Truth and embrace the peace of Christ

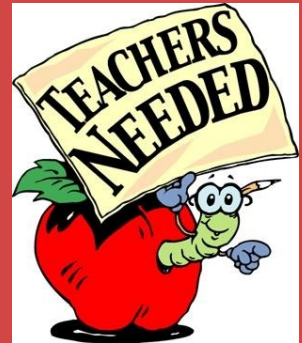

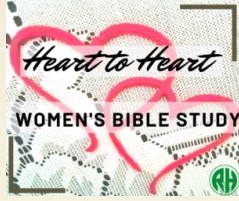

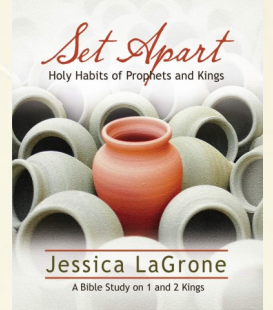
